- **Occupy the Dream** mobilizes in the United States for economic equality and justice under the First Amendment right of freedom of speech and right to assemble and to present grievances to the government.
- **Occupy the Dream** organizes around the principle of “operational unity” among diverse individuals, groups, constituencies, organizations, institutions, businesses, communities and other entities who all agree to work together to fulfill the mission of the Occupy the Dream movement.
